

## Top Tips for shooting and making a short video- MOV.I.E.-Erasmus+

(with camcorders, mobiles & cameras) by BashArt Creative

1. **Clean the lens** and Use the **landscape format**

2. **Light** on your filming subject from either left or right side-



3. **Steady your shots:** use a small tripod, ie., on a wall

4. **Sound distance** for mobile phones: 1 meter or less-if it is too noisy film when quite

5. **Film slowly:** observe and record each shot for at least 10-20 seconds

6. **Shot sizes in a variety** is best for editing, ie., far away shot, left or right angle, zooming...

7. **Frame your shots:** Try to put your filming subject to the left or right of the frame-the rule of thirds. As in these pictures



8. **Save** all the video clips and photos of your story **in one Film file** in a PC or laptop

9. Choose an **Editor** tool/programme and **Press the 'Make a video button'**

10. Start with writing your **film title** and choose video clips and images from your Film file on the editing Timeline

11. If you add music, make sure it is **free of rights soundtrack** or, authentic sounds, and start sounds or music before the corresponding image on the video editing Timeline for a more interesting effect.

12. **Preview** and **Click the "Make My Movie!" or "Save" button**
